Dóksa (DOXA) – Shine, Brightness, Splendor, Luminosity

JOHN 1:1-9

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. ⁴ In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. ⁵ **The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.** ⁶ There was a man sent from God whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. ⁸ He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light. ⁹ **The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world.**

Behold the Word. Behold the true light coming into the world.

BEHOLD HIS GLORY

Dóksa (doxa) – Viewpoint of VALUE, WORTH, & MAJESTY

JOHN 1:14, 16-18

¹⁴ The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. **We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.** - - - ¹⁶ Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. ¹⁷ For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. ¹⁸ **No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.**

**Behold the ultimate revelation of God's grace. Behold the Only One who shows us the Father.
Behold the Only One who shows us what has value and what is worthy of praise.**

BEHOLDING DELIBERATELY

PHILIPPIANS 4:8

⁸ Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—**if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.**
