### PROVERBS 8:8-5

<sup>8</sup> Does not wisdom call out? Does not understanding raise her voice? <sup>2</sup> At the highest point along the way, where the paths meet, **she takes her stand**; <sup>3</sup> beside the gate leading into the city, at the entrance, **she cries aloud**: <sup>4</sup> “To you, O people, I call out; I raise my voice to all mankind. <sup>5</sup> You who are simple, gain prudence; you who are foolish, set your hearts on it...”

### PROVERBS 1:7

### PROVERBS 4:23

<sup>23</sup> Above all else, guard your heart, for **everything you do flows from it**.

### PROVERBS 27:19

### PROVERBS 3:3

### PROVERBS 3:5-6 – TRUSTING SELF

<sup>5</sup> **Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding**; <sup>6</sup> in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

### PROVERBS 5:12 – CARELESS & RECKLESS

<sup>12</sup> You will say, “How I **hated discipline!** How my heart **spurned correction!**”

### PROVERBS 10:8 – BEING UNTEACHABLE

<sup>8</sup> **The wise in heart accept commands**, but a chattering fool comes to ruin.

### PROVERBS 7:25-26 – DECEPTION & TEMPTATION

<sup>25</sup> **Do not lust in your heart after her beauty or let her captivate you with her eyes.** <sup>24</sup> Now then, my sons, listen to me; pay attention to what I say. <sup>25</sup> Do not let your heart turn to her ways or stray into her paths. <sup>26</sup> Many are the victims she has brought down; her slain are a mighty throng.

### PROVERBS 18:12 – ARROGANCE

<sup>12</sup> **Before a downfall the heart is haughty**, but humility comes before honor.

### PROVERBS 23:7 – ENVY

<sup>17</sup> **Do not let your heart envy sinners**, but always be zealous for the fear of the Lord.

### COLOSSIANS 2:2-4

In Christ, <sup>3</sup> ...are hidden **all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge**. <sup>4</sup> I tell you this so that no one may deceive you by fine-sounding arguments.
